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### PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

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#### Our commitment

Our studio is committed to providing a safe environment for students, teachers and parents. Aggressive, threatening or other inappropriate behaviour by members, their families, their friends, and other dance personnel while attending the studio or event will not be tolerated.

These behaviours are outlined in our Child Safe Policy- Code of conduct and specifically include:

- using bad language
- harassing or ridiculing students, teachers, admin staff or other parents
- making racist, religious, sexist or other inappropriate comments to students, teachers, admin staff or other parents
- any threatening behaviour or physical altercation between students, teachers, admin staff or other parents
- putting undue pressure on children, berating them or putting down their performance

#### What we will do

- Provide students, their parents and other personnel with our Code of conduct and make clear what is expected and the consequences of non-compliance.
- Where possible, bind non-members by prominently displaying conditions of entry to studios and facilities and by requiring parents to abide by our studio Code of conduct.
- Reinforce messages of fair and respectful behaviour by displaying signs and posters around our facilities and providing information on our website, in our newsletter and through other studio communication.
- Encourage our teachers and officials to complete training to develop their skills and confidence.
- Encourage the reporting of incidents and investigate inappropriate behaviours as outlined in this policy and take disciplinary or whatever other actions as are deemed necessary.

#### What we ask you to do

- Help create a positive atmosphere for students, teachers, officials and other parents by showing respect for all, and be inclusive to all parents and students at all times.
- Abide by our school's Code of conduct and refrain from using bad language, harassing or ridiculing others or behaving in a threatening manner.

- If you are aware of inappropriate behaviour and you feel confident to do so, speak with the person and ask them to stop. If there is a teacher or admin staff present, ask for their assistance.
- Report any inappropriate behaviour to the Principal or someone in a position of authority.

### Non-Compliance

Parents or others found to have behaved inappropriately, will be subject to action as outlined in our Child Safety Policy-Code of conduct.
