



## [TIDC is an approved Sports Voucher Provider for Primary school age children](#)

'Primary School Aged' currently means where a child is attending or is eligible to attend primary school (between the years Reception to Year 7) in South Australia.

### HOW DOES SPORTS VOUCHERS WORK FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS?

#### Establish if My Child is Eligible

Sports Vouchers are available to all South Australian primary school aged children\*.R-7

Each eligible child is able to claim one voucher per calendar year.

#### Request to use your Sports Voucher

Let the provider know that you want to use your Sports Vouchers entitlement to discount \$100 from their membership fee. *The Sports Vouchers hard copy voucher form specifies all the details that clubs need to collect from you.*

#### Provide Information

You must then provide all the required details\*\* to the provider. The critical piece of information is your child's eleven (11) digit Medicare number or Australian visa number. Give your child's details to the club by: Filling out a [Sports Voucher – attached or available on their or our website.](#)

#### Pay

After you have provided all the details necessary to receive a voucher, the provider must reduce their membership fee by up to \$100. You must then pay the remaining balance. The preferred method is to provide the discount to membership fees at the time of payment (eg: membership fees are \$200, the parent will pay \$100 and the provider will claim the remaining \$100 from the Sports Vouchers team). Some providers are unable to offer a discount upfront at the time of registration (due to varying reasons) and in these instances, the parent pays the full membership fee and is refunded the \$100 once the provider has received reimbursement from the Sports Vouchers team.

#### Can the Sports Voucher be split between two providers?

No, the Sports Voucher can only be redeemed at one provider per calendar year. If the total membership fee is less than the voucher amount (\$100) then this is the maximum amount that the provider can claim (eg: if the registration fee is \$80, the provider can only claim \$80 and the child will forgo the remaining \$20 of the voucher).

#### I have paid a deposit before redeeming the voucher, can I still use it?

Yes the voucher can be used on the remaining balance.
